Zavadsky Vladimir Konstantinovich (1923-1995)

The 75th anniversary of the end of the great Patriotic war and the Victory over Nazism is approaching. The events of this bloody war affected almost every family, and mine is no exception.

My grandfather — Zavadsky Vladimir Konstantinovich – was a participant in the great Patriotic war. Grandfather was born on June 20, 1923 in the Ivanovo region, in the village of Gridkino. He completed 6 classes and graduated from school in 1938.

My grandfather went to war very young: at the age of 18, in September 1941, he was enlisted in the 270 Guards rifle regiment, served in the 89th Guards rifle Belgorod-Kharkiv red banner division as a scout.

Vladimir Konstantinovich participated in the fighting until March 3, 1945: on this day, my grandfather was wounded in the leg, after which he arrived in the hospital until July 1945.

My grandfather, Zavadsky Vladimir Konstantinovich, was awarded the Order of red star, Order of Glory 3rd class, Order of the Patriotic war of 2 degrees, a medal "For courage".

Grandfather successfully passed this terrible test of the great Patriotic war and returned home a living Hero.Vladimir Konstantinovich died on February 5, 1995 at 72 years of age.
