Loboda Andrey Petrovich



He was born on August 17, 1912 in the village of Bolshoe. Graduated from 2 classes of school. He worked on a collective farm, first as a tractor driver, then as a foreman. He was drafted into the army in 1931. After that, he worked on a collective farm. He was re-mobilized at the beginning of the great Patriotic war, served as a signalman in the artillery-310 division, 860 artillery regiment. In November 1941, he was wounded near Leningrad. Spent 8 months in hospitals. In 1942, he was commissioned for wounds. He has awards: the order of the Patriotic war of the first degree, the medal "for the victory over Germany", anniversary medals. Returned to the village of Zapadnoye in the Fedorovsky district. Worked as a foreman. In 1944, he was sent to the village of Grachevka, where he worked as the Chairman of the collective farm.

Then he worked as a bookkeeper. Retired on disability. Has labor awards: medals "for development of virgin lands", "for valiant labor". He died on July 27, 1994.
