

Vladimir Grobov 1927-1996

He was born in 1916 in the village of Mytishchi, Komsomolsky district, Ivanovo region. At the age of 17 he was called up for war in 1943. He fought in artillery troops. After the platoon was surrounded and re-formed into tank troops he fought in the city of Gorokhovets as a mechanic and driver of the tank. He took part in liberation of Prague and was there on Victory day in 1945. After the end of the war he served in the Far East. He returned home to Komsomolsk in 1949, worked at Ivgres as the head of the supply Department and then at the Kranelektroapparat plant, also as the head of the supply Department. He has some awards: the order of glory and a lot of medals.

Mikhail Grigoriev 1902-1989

He was born in 1902 in the village of Petrovo, Gavriilo-Posadsky district, Ivanovo region. From 1941 to 1944 Mikhail Ivanovich was fighting in tank troops. In 1944 he was bombed, concussed and became deaf. For his reason he was sent home where he started working on a collective farm. He has some awards: the order of the red star and some medals.
