Sergey Vasilyevich was born in 1909 in Furmanovsky district of the Ivanovo region. He studied at the Ivanovo State Textile Institute. In 1941, he was drafted into the army. He served as a political officer of the company. In the same year, he was wounded in the leg and was hospitalized. There he met his future wife. After the war, he was the head of the Lezhnevo spinning and weaving laboratory in the Ivanovo region. In May 1928, he joined the party of the Ivanovo district Committee of the CPSU. He died in the village of Lezhnevo.
