We have a lot of holidays in our country, but the greatest national holiday is Victory Day on the 9th of May. The Great Patriotic War finished that day in 1945. We celebrate the end of the war and remember the people who died for Russia.

In 2020 we celebrate the anniversary of the Victory Day. Seventy-five years ago, our soldiers gained the great victory. I am proud that my great-grandmother Krachalova Lyudmila Evstigneevna was among them.

My great-grandmother was born in Zolotylovsky Selsoviet of Vichugsky District of Ivanovo Region on August 23, 1919. Unfortunately, the exact date when she went to the front is not known. She was an anti-aircraft gunner. After the end of the Second World War my great-grandmother came back home. She died of stomach cancer on the night of June 30, 1974 the age of 54.

Her brothers Krachalov Alexander Evstigneevich, Krachalov Dmitry Evstigneevich and Krachalov Leonid Evstigneevich all died of wounds on the battlefield during the War. Dmitry was rewarded the medal "For Bravery".
